St. Johns River-to-Sea Loop Update

Progress on the St. Johns River-to-Sea Loop regional trail continues in St. Johns County with the recent ribbon cutting in Hastings and opening of the Cora C. Harrison Trailhead connecting 14 miles of paved, shared-use path. An evolving 260-mile, multi-use trail, the St. Johns River-to-Sea Loop will span from the St. Johns River to the Atlantic Ocean through five counties once complete. An FDOT Planning Study is currently underway with an expected completion date of fall 2019 and a community workshop will be hosted this summer to provide additional information and gather input from stakeholders.
